Monuments and Markers

As per Bylaw No. 03/02

- All monuments and markers shall be of granite, marble or stone.
- The foundations for monuments or markers shall be no less than level with the ground surrounding the grave, and at least six (6) inches wider and six (6) inches longer than the base of the monument.
- All monuments and markers must be set at the head of a grave lot.
- Cremation markers in the form of a ground level plaque marker may be placed directly above the vessel or container.
- Grave covers or ornamental rock of any type or description and of any material shall not be permitted.

Services and Fees

Cemetery Plot Purchase - \$100.00 + GST

- Cemetery plots shall be purchased from the Administrator or Assistant Administrator at the Ceylon Municipal Office.
- Certificates are issued for grave lots purchased within cemeteries under the municipality's jurisdiction.

Cremation Internment Services - \$150.00 + GST

- Service includes digging a 12" diameter cremation burial grave.
- Backfilling of grave not included with service.

Casket Internment Services - N/A

- Arranged through private contractor.

Additional Requested Maintenance, Labour - \$75.00/hr + GST

- Services include labour and tools required for plot maintenance. Rate is for two individuals per hour.

General Information

- Maintenance of plots and monuments is the responsibility of the executor or next of kin to the deceased.
- No more than two (2) casket internments, plus four (4) cremation burials will be permitted in each plot.
- Persons visiting the cemetery are asked to refrain from picking wild flowers.
- No person shall plant any trees, shrubs, or any other vegetation or do work of any kind in the Cemetery without the permission of the Municipal Council.
